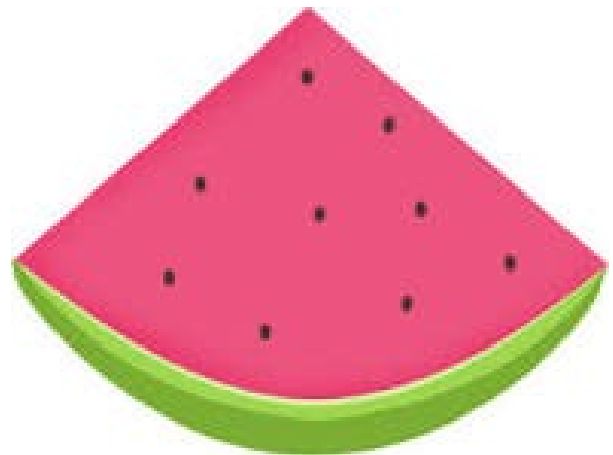

TN Safety Coordinator

No matter how long you have been riding, there will be a time or place where a situation may occur involving us or our trusted iron horses.

We are all creatures of habit and love to pack everything including the kitchen sink. But, are we including items that might help turn a bad day into a good day?

Basically, our bike comes with the owner's manual and a simplified tool kit that can hopefully guide and get us through a lot of fixes. However, this is not enough. Listed below are some items you may want to carry on your bike.

1. Battery type flashlight and/or battery free flashlight (wind up or shake for power)
2. Spare light bulbs, batteries & fuses
3. Jumper/booster cables (never know about a battery)
4. Insulated Cups (it gets thirsty riding)
5. Snacks (trail mix, power bars, fruit, etc.)
6. Cool vest, neck wraps, rain gear, extra types of gloves, long sleeve shirt (never know what Mother Nature will have in store on the ride)
7. Be MacGyver (duct tape & Swiss Army knife). Also electrical tape.
8. A small air pump/compressor to inflate a flat tire.
9. Tire repair kit (this can get you to a place where you can get a tire replaced). No spare tire provided.
10. A small adjustable wrench. (Sometimes this can be as handy as an entire toolbox)
11. With a lot of Allen Head bolts, the small folding type Allen wrench sets are really nice to have and they take up almost no room at all. Just be sure to buy metric.
12. Small screwdrivers that flip with the Phillips head on one end and the slotted head on the other end can be a real lifesaver.
13. A pair of pliers or channel locks can fix a broken lever or sometimes a broken cable. Remember these don't have to be big.
14. A small set of wire cutters can help cut a tie strap or a section of frayed wire if need be.
15. Any other tools to supplement the previous mentioned supply tool kit.
16. Hand gun (People really do include this. Make sure you have a license to carry a concealed weapon)
17. Charmin to go (you never know when you have to go)
18. Plastic tie straps (these can, in some instances, replace lost bolts)
19. First Aid Kit (even small separate bottle with personal meds)
20. Maps/atlas (still needed at times) and/or GPS
21. Cell phones to summon help (these are now everyday items)
22. Emergency ID information

You can always use the above as a guideline since there are still many other good items to include in your kit. All of these can be carried in a very small amount of space. For some, more items will be packed, for others may be less, all depending on individual needs. They can sometimes get you out of a really tight jam.

And remember if all or some of the above doesn't work, you will always have something to tinker with until the tow truck arrives!
